

#### **Editorial**

Our country, the largest democracy in the world, is now witnessing the festival of elections. As the citizens of this beloved country, we all are excited to cast our votes and choose the right representatives. However, the percentage of participation of the voters in the electoral process is not very encouraging: it was 66.14 for the first phase, 66.71 for the second and 64.58 for the third phase. Moreover, the percentage of participation of the voters in majority of the states ranged between 50 to 75%. Many states with large population recorded very low voter turnout. In a country which has recently celebrated 75 years of Independence, this development seems very alarming. Students, teachers and administrators in all the colleges and universities should work as



brand ambassadors and encourage people in their vicinity to come out in large numbers and cast their valuable votes in all the elections to choose the right governments and take the country to greater heights of success.

It is because of the dynamic and visionary leadership, guidance and mentorship provided by our Honourable Vice Chancellor Prof Nageshwar Rao, his team of Pro Vice Chancellors, Directors of Schools of Studies and Divisions, the untiring efforts of the Regional Centres across the country, the University has been at the forefront of major transformations in the sphere of higher education in the country. The collaborative initiative of IGNOU and UNICEF to provide career guidance to the learners through the YuVaah programme has widened the scope of its activities. Apart from providing career counselling to the learners through the YuVaah programme, UNICEF will be training one academic from each of the Regional Centres to motivate the learners to take advantage of the programme. The Regional Services Division and the Schools of Studies at the headquarters have been active in organising regular interactive sessions with the faculty for orienting the academic counsellors and Regional Centres in providing quality support services to the learners. Among the many digital initiatives undertaken to enhance its outreach and impact among the people, the University has geared up to augment the infrastructure facilities in the Swayamprabha studios located in the Regional Centres across the country to ensure the transmission of quality live sessions in the regional languages.

During the last two months, Regional Centre, Patna has galvanised the activities in the LSC in the Regional Centre (0500) by appointing the Part Time Functionaries and conducting face to face counselling sessions in the post-graduate programmes. In the admissions for the January 2024 cycle, Regional Centre Patna has registered record enrolment of 43028, highest since its inception in 1991. There has been wonderful response of learners for the Post graduate Programmes in Science like MSc Physics, MSc (Geography) and MSc(Chemistry). Efforts are being made to activate and popularise other MSC Programmes for the July 2024 cycle. As a part of its academic tradition, the Regional Centre organised webinars on the International Women's Day on "Women Empowerment: The Myth and Reality", "Female Participation in the Democratic Process in India" and "Educational Empowerment of Women through Open, Online and Distance Learning" in the months of March and April for expanding the knowledge base of the staff, students and academic counsellors.


#### Activities, Achievements and Initiatives of the University


#### Meeting with PVCs on Swayamprabha






#### **Interaction with the faculty of Economics**






#### Online Meeting with UNICEF & RSD



#### Webinar of School of Law on Bhartiya Nagrik Suraksha Sanhinta 2023: An Overviev

"Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita 2023: An Overview" by Prof Asad Malik, Faculty of Law, Jamia Millia Islamia, New Delhi at 3 PM on 23rd April 2024. Teachers and academics from the Schools and Regional Centres, Research scholars and some students participated in this webinar. Prof Swati Patra, Director School of Law, welcomed all the audience and highlighted the significance of organising the webinar. Prof Asad Malik, the elaborated on

the various provisions of Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 and highlighted the various provisions like electronic form of communication, community service as a form of punishment, complaint against public servant, precognizance hearing, provision of hearing and judgment in absentia and so on. He emphasized that the new law has mainly provided for the use of technology, time bound justice delivery and adopted a victim-centric approach by increasing their participation in the process.





#### Orientation Programme for the Academic Counsellors of School of Agriculture








#### Online Awareness-cum-Admission Drive










#### Online Grievance Redressal Session






#### Webinar on Female Participation in the Democratic Process in India
