EDITORIAL

The first phase of the New Year spreading over two months has been a vibrant period for the University as well as the Regional Centres. The University has made great strides in academic, extension and outreach activities.

The University has been awarded second position in the national Swachh Campus Ranking 2019 of Higher Educational Institutions among the Non-Residential Universities by UGC. This great honour and achievement of the university inspired it to observe 16-31 January as Swachhata Pakhwara with many activities. The university at the headquarters as well as the Regional Centres took up many activities during the Pakhwada and significantly contributed to the creation of a clean and green environment in the country. In continuation of its commitment to clean environment, the University has signed an MOU with HFM Solar Power Private Ltd to make use of solar power at the headquarters and reduce carbon emissions.

Enrolment in the university has been on the increase. The Regional Centre had a record enrolment of 51817 in 2019. In 2020, it is expected to achieve the target enrolment of 60,000. In January 2020 cycle only, it has already achieved 150%. This has been possible because of the unstinted efforts of the staff at the Learner Support Centres, Regional Centre and timely support from the enabling divisions at the headquarters.

The greatest academic achievement of the University has been the exemption accorded to it from the University Grants Commission(Online Course or Programmes) Regulations, 2018 vide Gazette Notification dated 17th January 2020. Prof Nageshwar Rao, Honourable Vice Chancellor has congratulated the IGNOU fraternity on this achievement and has hoped that it would bring a new era in the history of the university.

The Regional Services Division, in collaboration with the schools at headquarters has started the orientation of academic counsellors through the teleconferencing mode. Till date such orientation programmes have been organized for four Masters Degree programmes and one diploma programme. More orientation programmes for other programmes have been scheduled in the month of March 2020. The Regional Centre has also started the orientation programme for academic counsellors after a long gap. The first phase of orientation programme was held on the 2nd of February and the 2nd phase has been scheduled to be held in March 2020. The Regional Centre in collaboration with NIIT, Patna also organized a one day Seminar on *Digitisation: Future Job Prospect*. The University has started a Web Enabled Academic Support for all low enrolment programmes and this has been planned to be extended to the popular programmes later. Two faculty development programmes have been organized by NCIDE and STRIDE to train the faculty in developing online programmes, statistics and research methodology. All efforts are being put in by the University to integrate ICT in teaching-learning transactions and enhance the accuracy, efficiency and transparency of the student support services.

A new page IT Today has been added to keep the readers updated about the changes and developments in the IT sector.

Constructive suggestions for improvement in the content and style of presentation of the Newsletter are solicited.

UNIVERSITY GRANTS COMMISSION

NOTIFICATION

New Delhi, the 17th January, 2020

F. No. 2-5/2019 (OL).—In exercise of the powers conferred by sub-section (1) of section 26 read with clause (j) of section 12 of the University Grants Commission Act, 1956 (3 of 1956), the University Grants Commission hereby makes the following regulations to amend the University Grants Commission (Online Courses or Programmes) Regulations, 2018, namely:-

1. Short title and commencement. —

- (1) These regulations may be called the University Grants Commission (Online Courses or Programmes) Amendment Regulations, 2020.
- (2) They shall come into the force on the date of their publication in the Official Gazette.

2. In the University Grants Commission (Online Courses or Programmes) Regulations, 2018, in regulation 2, in sub-regulation (2), the following proviso shall be inserted, namely:-

“Provided that the University Grants Commission may, by order, exempt the Indira Gandhi National Open University, a university established under the Indira Gandhi National Open University Act, 1985 (50 of 1985), from the application of these regulations, considering the objectives of the said Act”.

Note : The principal regulations were published in the Gazette of India, Extraordinary, Part-III, Section 4, *vide* notification F. No. 1-19/2016 (CPP-II/DEB-I) dated the 4th July, 2018.

IGNOU has been exempted by the University Grants Commission from the University Grants Commission(Online Course or Programmes) Regulations, 2018 vide Gazette Notification dated 17th Jaunuary 2020. Prof Nageshwar Rao, Honourable Vice Chancellor congratulated the IGNOU fraternity on this achievement and hoped that it would bring a new era in the history of the university. He invoked the IGNOU fraternity to make use of this opportunity and develop learner-centric online programmes for gaining knowledge and make them ready for the 21st century.



Orientation of Academic Counsellors through Tele-Conferencing Mode

The University with the coordination between the Regional Services Division and respective schools, has started the Orientation Programme for Academic Counselors through Teleconferencing. Till date Orientation Programme for the academic counsellors of programmes like Diploma in Early Childhood Care and Education(DECE), MA(Psychology), MA (Hindi), MA(English) and Masters in Social Work(MSW) have already been held. Many such teleconferencing sessions for programmes like Certificate in Food and Nutrition(CFN), Diploma in Dairy technology(DDT), Diploma in Nutrition and Health Education(DNHE), Diploma in Event Management(DEVMT), PG Diploma in International Business Operations(PGDIBO), Master of Tourism and Travel Management(MTTM) and Masters in Commerce(M.Com) have been scheduled in the month of March 2020. The schedule has been uploaded on the website of the Regional Centre (rcpatna.ignou.ac.in).

IGNOU Goes Green, Signs MOU with HFM Solar Power

In order to adopt clean energy IGNOU signed an MOU with HFM Solar Power Private Ltd. for the installation of Grid Connected Rooftop Solar Power Plant on its campus. The Solar Plant will be built in collaboration with the Ministry of New and Renewable Energy(MNRE), Indraprastha Power Generation Company Limited (IPGCL), Energy Efficiency and Renewable Energy management Centre(EEREM), Gov of NCT Delhi undertaking. The project is estimated to save 3 million rupees annually and reduce emissions of 650 tons of carbon dioxide which is equivalent to planting nearly 32000 trees.

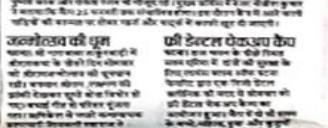
